

Historic Master Bath Addition

An addition of a master bathroom suite was the inspiration for this project in Walla Walla, Washington. The 1907 house originally had only one bathroom on the second floor. The owner desired a retreat that would incorporate a soaking tub, a large shower and a new closet. At the same time, it was important that the addition not detract from the original design and form of the house. The interior and exterior were designed to seem as if they were an existing feature of the house, rather than an addition.

Period details throughout the addition allow for a seamless transition from existing space to the new master retreat.
